Thursday April 9, 2020 will be moved to Thursday May 7, 2020 at the previously set time.

Probates



**AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER FOR PROBATE CASES
DURING THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY**

If anything in this Order is in conflict with AO-2020-12, please follow the directives in this Order:

Probates

Any probate case set before Judge McCoy between March 18, 2020, and April 8, 2020, for Appointment of Personal Representative or Special Administrator may mail the Order to Judge McCoy for signature, along with Letters signed before a notary, **Consent and Waivers by all heirs**, and copy of Publication and/or Affidavit of Mailing.

All other Probate matters will be reset accordingly:

Wednesday March 25, 2020 will be moved to Wednesday April 15, 2020 at 9:30 am.

Wednesday April 1, 2020 will be moved to Wednesday April 22, 2020 at 9:30 am.

Attorneys will be responsible for ensuring proper Notice of the new hearing date is given to all necessary parties.
