**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER EXTENDING
TEMPORARY MEASURES**

The President of the United States and the Governor of the State of Oklahoma having declared a state of emergency and The Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma and The Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals having entered the First Emergency Joint Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster (SCAD No. 2020-24), and recognizing that the concerns surrounding the pandemic will exist longer than originally anticipated, the District Court of Rogers County hereby extends the temporary measures outlined in AO-2019-11 and AO-2019-13 until April 20, 2020.

All judicial offices and courts are closed until April 20, 2020 regardless of whether the Courthouse is open to the public or not. Judges and staff are authorized to work remotely, as they see fit. A rotation schedule has been put into place so that at least one judge will be in the courthouse during all business hours. All emergency matters should start with a call to the Court Clerk's office at 918-923-4565 or 918-923-4549 and they will help direct you to the correct judicial officer handling the emergency matter.
