**SECOND ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER EXTENDING
TEMPORARY MEASURES**

On March 24, 2020, Governor J. Kevin Stitt issued the Fourth Amended Executive Order 2020-7 and ordered that additional steps be taken to protect all Oklahomans from the growing threat of COVID-19. Additionally, on March 27, 2020 the Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma issued the Second Emergency Joint Order Regarding The Covid-19 State of Disaster (SCAD-2020-29) directing the District Courts to continue with their emergency measures through May 15, 2020, and recognizing that the concerns surrounding the pandemic will exist longer than originally anticipated, the District Court of Rogers County hereby extends the temporary measures outlined in AO-2019-11, AO-2019-13 and AO-2020-15 until May 15, 2020.

All judicial offices and courts are closed, with the exception of emergency matters, until May 15, 2020 regardless of whether the Courthouse is open to the public. Judges and staff are authorized to work remotely, as they see fit. A rotation schedule has been put into place so that at least one judge will be in the courthouse during all business hours. All emergency matters should start with a call to the Court Clerk's office at 918-923-4565 or 918-923-4549 and they will help direct you to the correct judicial officer handling the emergency matter.
